• Sam Pollard began playing the piano at the age of five and has never looked back. As a gifted composer and an accomplished multi instrumentalist in piano, keyboards, electric and acoustic guitars, cornet, trumpet and trombone, Sam Pollard has a voice that can brilliantly blend various styles to create a sound that is uniquely his own.

• Sam Pollard is no cycling professional and yet he made his way across Australia in 26 days on his bicycle. Immediately afterwards, he participated in an Ironman triathlon. Sam embarked on a one-of-a-kind tour that has never been done before.



• Sam completed his debut album "World of Difference" with his band and producer Jimi Maroudas at Sing Sing Studios in Melbourne. The result is an amazingly fluid and enlightening listening experience as his music crosses a number of genres from acoustic singer-songwriter to alternative rock. The album caught the ears of Damien Reilly, CEO of Blue Pie Records USA, who quickly signed Sam to a recording and publishing agreement. His EP World Of Difference was a top 10 ARIA charting release and still continues to get air play arround the world.

• Planet Blue Pictures, Blue Pie Records and Sam Pollard brings this story to your screens in a documentary series called A World Of Difference. The film features local communities across the country and the quirky traits that make living in regional Australia unique. A fast, flat course in the scenic town of Busselton

• The Busselton Ironman in Western Australia is renowned worldwide for being the place to go for a personal best. The bike and run courses are among the flattest on the global Ironman circuit. With stunning seaside views and unrivaled local support, it's easy to see why this is a must-do event for athletes around the globe.



3.8km Swim Course

Cutoff times on swim course:

- Individuals: 2 hour 20 min
- Sam Pollard: 1 Hour

The swim is a one-lap, 'M' shaped course, commencing in front of the goose, alongside the historic Busselton Jetty.

180km Pedal Mafia Bike Course

Cutoff times on bike course:

- Individuals: 8 hours
- Sam Pollard: 5 hours 30 min

The bike is a two-lap course. The bike leg exits the transition area at the southern end of Barnard Park directly onto Marine Parade heading east.

42.2km Keep On Running - The Run Course

Cutoff times on run course:

- Individuals: 7 hours
- Sam Pollard: 4 hours 50 min

The run is a 3 lap course along Geographe Bay. Participants exit T2 on Geographe Bay Rd, and cross straight onto the beach footpath heading east.

• After riding his bike across Australia with his two good friends and then competing in the Busselton Ironman triathlon, it's no wonder that Sam needed to have a rest!
